Participation Options and Proceeds

Girl Scouts can participate in one or all options listed below. All proceeds stay local. **New for 2026:** Troops earn **15%** on all items sold in proceeds. Senior & Ambassador Troops can opt-out of rewards to earn **18%** in proceeds.

Fall FUNdraiser: Your Key Volunteer Duties

This program is a snap! Follow the steps and dates below to keep on task.

Before the Sale | September 1–19

Receive troop materials from your Community Product Leader.
Check your inbox the week of September 14 for a link to set up your M2OS account.

1. **Watch** the training video and use the M2OS Quick Tips Sheet for system instructions.
2. **Add** or verify troop **bank account** information.
3. **View** your Troop roster. If anyone is missing, remind the family to complete registration.
4. **Approve/edit** the parent/adult emails to send a Go Day reminder email.



Girl Scouts participating in online sales will complete a permission form in M2OS. For those participating only in snack order card sales, direct them to complete the online permission form. Attend our optional, virtual Troop Check-in & Chat session or view the recording in gsLearn. Distribute family guides and (if needed) snack order cards.

During the Sale | September 20–October 21

Note: Girl Scouts can join in the program any time during these dates.

1. **Direct** Girl Scouts to set up their M2OS online account starting on September 20.
2. **Read your “In a Nutshell” emails.**
3. **Confirm** your mailing address for the girl-delivered snack sales and rewards by October 16. See In a Nutshell for details.
4. **Remind** families to enter their snack order card sales into M2OS by October 21.

After the Sale | October 22–December 17

1. **Enter** any missing snack order card sales and rewards selections between October 22 and October 24.
 - No action is needed for online sales, which are credited at the time of purchase.
 - Community Product Leaders can enter snack order card sales through 11:59 pm on October 25.
 - **No late orders can be accepted after October 25.**
2. **Receive** your girl-delivered snack orders and rewards the week of November 16. Items will ship to the address provided to River Valleys.
3. **Distribute** snacks and rewards to families.
4. **Finalize** snack order card deposits. If needed, complete the Finance Inventory Issue Form by December 8.
 - The balance due will be collected with an ACH withdrawal from the troop bank account on December 17.

Banking and Finance Information

Verify/enter your troop’s bank account information in M2OS.

Snack order card sales payment details:

- Girl Scouts can collect cash or checks (made payable to Girl Scouts) from customers at the time of order or at the time of delivery.
- Snack order card payments from families to the Troop can be accepted via cash, check, online payment systems (Venmo/Paypal Friends & Family), or deposit funds directly into the troop account.
- Juliettes are mailed deposit slips to deposit all money for snack order card sales into the River Valleys Wells Fargo bank account.



Collect final payment from families by December 6.

Deposit all money collected for snack order card sales into the troop bank account by December 8.

The balance due will be collected with an ACH withdrawal from the troop bank account on December 17.

- View the Troop Summary Report in M2OS to see the total sales, payment collected online, proceeds earned, and the total due. For troops owed proceeds due to high-levels of online payments, proceeds will be transferred to the troop account on December 21.

The Finance/Inventory Issue Form is completed by December 8: if a family owes money to the troop, your troop received an NSF (non-sufficient funds) check(s), or your troop was charged bank fees due to high deposit activity. Find this form on our website or in your *In a Nutshell* email.
